Summer Reading 2018 5th - 8th grades

You are required to read two books before school begins.

The mandatory book is: A Long Walk to Water- Linda Sue Park

The assessment for this book will be a short answer quiz given the first day of class.

You are also required to read one book from the following five titles:

The Unwanteds- McMann
George Washington's Spy- Woodruff
Chasing Lincoln's Killer- Swanson
Ender's Game- Card
How to Die of Embarrassment Every Day- Hodgman

The assessment for the book of your choice will be your choice of one of the following STREAM based activities. This will be completed in school during the first week of school. You do not need to do this during the summer; it will be done in school.

Option 1: Design and create a model of one of the main characters in the novel using materials of your choice from the Maker. Space. Your character should have at least 6 features that directly relate to the text. (If a character loves Star Wars, he/she could be wearing a Star Wars t-shirt, etc.) You will be given a graphic organizer to help plan your model.

Option 2: Create a Google Slide presentation including the major elements of your novel. (title, author, setting, characters, summary, conclusion, message/theme) Include relevant images and make it visually appealing as well as informative.

Option 3: Design and create a comic strip detailing the important events of the book. Include at least 10 frames with colored illustrations and accompanying text to show your understanding of the major events of the novel.

Option 4: Create a poster of the setting of the story. Include at least five quotes from the book describing the setting. Be as detailed as possible. Use color, be creative, and stick to the text.


